

## ASPEN APEX EARWARMER

## Materials:

ww yarn OR dk weight yarn
J hook
yarn needle
tape measure

## Abbreviations:

ch = chain
rnd $=$ round
sl st $=$ slip stitch
hdc = half double crochet
ps = pineapple stitch
Special instruction: To determine size, measure circumference of head just above the ears. This will determine the length of your starting chain.

You will be working in the back bump of the stitches for part of this pattern. It is the horizontal 'bar' located behind, and just below, the two top loops. If you are not familiar with this technique, here is a video tutorial.

Use a single strand if working with ww yarn!
Special Stitch: Pineapple stitch--insert hook under the top loops, yo, draw up a loop, insert under the next top loops, yo, draw up a loop, yo and draw through all three loops on the hook.

Here is a tutorial on how to do the pineapple stitch. Follow the instructions for Row 2, but do not fasten off as instructed, as you will be working in the round without turning.

## Pattern:

Ch an even number until the length of the chain equals your head circumference measurement. Join with a sl st in a circle, being careful not to twist the chain.

Rnds 1 \& 2: Ch1, hdc in back bump around, sl st join to 1st hdc.
Rnds 3-10: (you will start by working in the same as the join for each round) *Ch 1, ps; repeat from * around, sl st join to 1st ch.

Rnd 11: Ch 1, hdc in back bump around, sl st join to 1st hdc.
Fasten off. Weave in ends.

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## Puff Peak Earwarmer <br> by <br> Joyful Yarns Crochet



## Materials:

ww yarn OR dk weight yarn
J hook
yarn needle
tape measure

## Abbreviations:

ch = chain
rnd = round
$\mathrm{sc}=$ single crochet
sl st = slip stitch
hdc $=$ half double crochet
fpdc = front post double crochet
bpdc = back post double crochet
BLO = back loop only
Special instruction: To determine size, measure circumference of head just above the ears. This will determine the length of your starting chain.

You will be working in the back bump of the stitches for part of this pattern. It is the

## You will be working with the yarn double stranded if you are using dk weight yarn!

 Use a single strand if working with ww yarn!Special Stitch: Puff stitch—[yo, insert hook, yo, pull up a loop] 4 times in same stitch, yo, pull through all loops on the hook, ch 1 to close the stitch.

## Pattern:

Chain a multiple of 6 until the length of the chain equals your head circumference measurement. Join with a sl st in a circle, being careful not to twist the chain.

Rnd 1: Ch1, hdc in back bump of the chain stitches around. SI st join to 1st hdc.
Rnds 2 \& 3: Ch2. Fpdc, bpdc alternating around. SI st join to 1 st fpdc.
Rnd 4: Ch 5 (counts as dc and 2 ch), puff st into same as join. *Skip 2 sts, [dc, ch2, puff st] all in next st. * Repeat from * to * around to $3^{\text {rd }}$ from last st. Sk last 2 sts, sl st join to the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of the beginning ch5. TURN.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sk $1^{\text {st }}$ st, *work long dc into the first of the 2 skipped sts in rnd below, 1 sc into puff st, 1sc into ch2 space. * Repeat from * to * around, sl st to $1^{\text {st }}$ long dc. TURN. Rnd 6: Repeat Rnd 4.
Rnd 7: Repeat Rnd 5.
Rnd 8: Ch 1, hdc in each st around. Sl st join to 1st hdc.
Rnds 9 \& 10: Repeat Rnds 2 \& 3.
Fasten off. Weave in ends.

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## SLALOM SLOPE EARWARMER

## Materials:

ww OR dk weight yarn
J hook
yarn needle
tape measure

## Abbreviations:

ch = chain
rnd $=$ round
$\mathrm{sc}=$ single crochet
sl st $=$ slip stitch
hdc = half double crochet
fpdc $=$ front post double crochet
bpdc $=$ back post double crochet
BLO = back loop only
sk = skip
Special Stitch: 5dc cluster--yo, insert hook, yo and draw up a loop, yo and pull through two loops. Repeat 4 more times. Yo, and draw through all remaining loops, ch 1 to close the stitch.

Special instruction: To determine size, measure circumference of head just above the ears. This will determine the length of your starting chain.

You will be working in the back bump of the stitches for part of this pattern. It is the horizontal 'bar' located behind, and just below, the two top loops. you are not familiar with this technique, here is a video tutorial.

You will be working with the yarn double stranded if you are using $d k$ weight yarn!
Use a single strand if working with ww yarn!

## Pattern:

Ch in a count of 4 (ie, $44,48,52$ ) until the length of the chain equals your head circumference measurement. If you reach your measurement before finishing a count of 4, it is ok to use the lesser set count, as the stitch pattern used has quite a bit of stretch to it. Join with a sl st in a circle, being careful not to twist the chain.

Rnd 1: Ch 1. Working in back bump of the chain stitches, hdc in same as join and in each st around. Sl st join to 1st hdc. (This will create an edge to mimic the top edge when it is finished.)
Rnds 2 \& 3: Ch2. Fpdc, bpdc alternating around. Sl st join to 1 st fpdc.
Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in same as join. [*ch3, 5dc cluster in same, sk 3 *, sc in next st. Repeat from [ to ] around to last 5 sts. Repeat from * to * once. Sl st join to 1 st sc. Turn.
Rnd 5: Ch 3 (counts as dc), [ ${ }^{*}$ sk $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$; sc in next 2 chs, hdc in next ch, $*$ dc in next sc ]. Repeat from [ to ] around to last sts Repeat from * to * once. Sl st join to top of beginning ch 3. Turn. Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in 1 st dc (ch3 from Rnd 5), [ $* 3 \mathrm{ch}$, 5 dc cluster in same, sk 3 sts, ${ }^{*}$ sc in next dc ${ }^{*}$ ]. Repeat from [ to ] around to last 4 sts. Repeat * to * once. Sl st join to 1 st sc. DO NOT TURN. Rnd 7: Ch1, hdc in sc, *2 hdc in ch 3 sp , hdc in top of cluster st *. Repeat * to * around. Sl st join to 1 st hdc.
Rnds 8 \& 9: Repeat Rnds 2 \& 3.
Fasten off. Weave in ends.

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## SNOWY SUMMIT EARWARMER <br> by <br> Joyful Yarns Crochet



## Materials:

ww yarn OR dk weight yarn
J hook
yarn needle
tape measure

## Abbreviations:

ch = chain
rnd = round
$\mathrm{sc}=$ single crochet
sl st = slip stitch
hdc $=$ half double crochet
fpdc $=$ front post double crochet
bpdc = back post double crochet
BLO = back loop only
Special instruction: To determine size, measure circumference of head just above the ears. This will determine the length of your starting chain.

You will be working with the yarn double stranded if you are using dk weight yarn!
Use a single strand if working with ww yarn!

## Pattern:

Ch an even number until the length of the chain equals your head circumference measurement. Join with a sl st in a circle, being careful not to twist the chain.

Rnd 1: Ch 1. Working in back bump of the chain stitches, hdc in same as join and in each st around. SI st join to 1 st hdc. (This will create an edge to mimic the top edge when it is finished.)
Rnd 2: Ch2. Fpdc, bpdc alternating around. SI st join to 1 st fpdc.
Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in each st around. SI st join to 1 st sc.
Rnd 4-11: Ch 1. Working in back bump of stitches, sc around. SI st join to 1st st.
Rnd 12: Ch 2. Working in BLO, hdc in each st around. SI st join to 1 st hdc.
Rnd 13: Ch 2. Fpdc, bpdc alterating around. SI st join to 1 st fpdc.
Fasten off. Weave in ends.
**If you would like the head band to be wider or narrower, work more or less of the Rnd 5-8 repeat.

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## THISTLE MOUNTAIN EARWARMER <br> by <br> Joyful Yarns Crochet



## Materials:

ww yarn
H hook
yarn needle
tape measure

Abbreviations:
ch = chain
rnd \(=\) round
\(\mathrm{sc}=\) single crochet
sl st \(=\) slip stitch
6dc popcorn \(=6\) double crochet popcorn (see special stitch instructions below)
fpdc \(=\) front post double crochet
bpdc - back post double crochet
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Special instruction: To determine size, measure circumference of head just above the ears. This will determine the length of your starting chain.

You will be working in the back bump of the stitches for part of this pattern. It is the horizontal 'bar' located behind, and just below, the two top loops. you are not familiar with this technique, here is a video tutorial.

Special Stitch: 6 double crochet popcorn--work 6 dc into indicated stitch. Remove hook from loop,
insert into top of first dc, reaching behind the dcs, and back into the loop. Pull loop through first dc, and ch 1 to close the popcorn stitch.

## Pattern:

## Starting chains do not count as a stitch.

Ch a multiple of 12 until the length of the chain equals your head circumference measurement. Join with a sl st in a circle, being careful not to twist the chain.

Rnd 1: Ch2, dc in back bump of each st around. Sl st join to 1 st dc.
Rnd 2: Ch 2. Fpdc, bpdc around. Sl st to 1 st fpdc.
Rnd 3: Ch 1 , sc in same as join and in each around, sl st join to $1^{\text {st }}$ sc.
Rnd 4: Ch1, sc in same as join and next 11 sts. *Ch 10, sc in same (12th st) three times; sc in next 12 sts. * Repeat from * to * around. Sl st join to 1st sc.
Rnd 5: Ch 1, *sc in next 11 sts, sc in center sc of group of three in the 12 st (working behind the loops). * Repeat from * to * around. Sl st join to 1 st sc.
Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in each st around, sl st join to 1 st sc . (It helps to push the loops forward out of the way to see the stitches and make sure you don't miss one.)
Rnd 7: Ch 1 , sc in next 2 sts, *sc in next, catching the 3 rd ch10 loop; sc in next 5, sc in next, catching the 1 st ch10 loop; sc in next $5 *$ Repeat from * to * around to last 3 sts. Sc in each of the last 3 sts. Sl st join to the 1 st sc.
Rnd 8: Ch 1, sc in each st around, sl st join to 1 st sc.
Rnd 9: Ch 1, *11 sc; in next sc, working through the center ch10 loop, work a 6dc popcorn *. Repeat from * to * around. Sl st join to 1st sc.
Rnd 10: Ch $1, * 11 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ in ch1 from 6 dc popcorn st in rnd 8 *. Repeat from * to * around. Sl st join to 1 st sc.
Rnd 11: Ch 1, sc in each st around. Sl st join to 1st sc.
Rnd 12: Ch 2, dc in each st around. Sl st join to 1st dc.
Rnd 13: Ch 2. Fpdc, bpdc around. Sl st join to 1st fpdc.
Fasten off. Weave in ends.

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
